I am writing to you to share my support for the Survivors of the Île-à-la-Crosse Residential School. Recently a class action suit was launched to call on the Saskatchewan and Federal Government to recognize and address the impact of the residential school. I am urging you to come to the table and negotiate a fair and just settlement.

Île-à-la-Crosse is an important, historical community in Saskatchewan which also was home to a residential school that was horrific and violent for the students who attended. The majority of the students who attended Île-à-la-Crosse Residential School were from Métis families in and around Île-à-la-Crosse.

Île-à-la-Crosse Residential School was open for over 100 years and in similar fashion to First Nations, students were subject to neglect and abuse while attending the school. As you should be aware, the provincial government was responsible for the operation of the school and is included in the class action suit and must be accountable for being part of a horrific part of Saskatchewan history.

In addition, Métis students across the Métis homelands were not recognized in the residential school agreement despite being subjected to the same treatment. Please do what is right for our province and our country. Recognize and honour those truths from students!
